Eric **DeCamps**

Eric DeCamps is the personification of a magician. Debonair and engaging, enchanting and mystifying, every one of his performances weaves compelling storytelling with visual artistry. His signature style of intimate conjuring draws audiences into the magic, making them a part of the experience.



On stage, familiar objects — a champagne glass, a few silver dollars, a piece of tissue paper, a silk cord, and a deck of playing cards — come alive in his hands, performing the seemingly impossible at every turn.

A serious student of the art for over 40 years, Mr. DeCamps began his apprenticeship at New York's legendary Magic Towne House. He went on to perform regularly for over a decade at the celebrated Greenwich Village nightclub, Mostly Magic. In the years since, he has brought his elegant style of magic to exclusive events across the United States, Europe, Japan, and South America. Fortune 500 companies — including Time Warner, Google, General Motors, JP Morgan Chase, and American Express — have trusted him to entertain their most valued clients.

In 2007, Mr. DeCamps collaborated with director Steve Ciuffo to create his first one-man show, which debuted at the Lincoln Room at the 3 West Club in Rockefeller Center. The following year, the show was reimagined in partnership with MAC Award winner Bob Fitch and enjoyed four successful eight week runs at Manhattan's renowned Metropolitan Room. Most recently, Mr. DeCamps completed a five-week run at the National Opera America Center — every performance sold out and ended with a standing ovation.

Mr. DeCamps' accolades are as impressive as his performances. In 1989 and 1990, he won back-to-back Silver Medals from the Society of American Magicians. In 1995, the Society awarded him its Gold Medal of Excellence for Close-Up Magic—he is only the second magician in the organization's 123-year history to receive this honor. His other recognitions include the prestigious Milbourne Christopher Foundation Award, Backstage Magazine's Bistro Award for Variety Artist of the Year, the New York Magic Conference Lifetime Achievement Award, MVP at the 2023 4F Convention, and he is proud to be named the 2025 4F Guest of Honor.

Horret Wu was originally recognized as an underground card magician from Taiwan. During college, he started entering magic competitions around Asia and winning awards for his unique and challenging card magic.

In 2015, Horret won the 1st prize at the FISM World Championship of Magic with his signature Jumbo Card Act. Since then, he has become a rising star in Asia and has been invited to perform in more than 15 countries, including multiple times at The Magic Castle, and on Penn & Teller's FOOL U.S.

Horret also promotes the art magic. In 2018, he launched a small video project, combining magic and news in Taiwan. The videos got millions of views, raising public interest and causing discussions about magic in an unconventional way.

First Time Performers Guide 1/4

Welcome to 4F! We are really excited to have you perform for the first time and want the experience to be great for you. To make your performance as stress-free as possible, we've created this document to give you a better understanding of what you can expect for the performing conditions. The number of magicians in the audience ranges from 200-225. The first few rows of seats are at floor level and then the seating is tiered on two additional levels of risers. The viewing angles at the sides is almost 180 degrees, but not quite.



Airport Rides

The Millenium Hotel offers a shuttle service – call them at **(716) 681-2400** when you arrive. If there is no shuttle service available, take a cab and the hotel will reimburse you for it.



First Time Performers Guide 2/4

Performing

Everyone has to perform their first time at 4F. You have up to five minutes to do your routine, 10 minutes if it is a competition act (e.g. FISM). If you are doing a FISM act, please let Glenn know. Our advice is to do what you do best - some solid magic, rather than a new routine you are still working on. The 4F family wants you to succeed, so take a deep breath, relax and enjoy yourself.

Lights

If you haven't performed on a stage before, one element of the set-up is that there are stage lights shining on the performance area. This makes it difficult to see the audience past the first few rows. During your practice sessions, you may consider having a few bright photography lights directed towards yourself to mimic the conditions you'll experience at the convention. If you are standing for your set and not seated at the close-up table, remember to stay in the area where the lighting is the brightest. This will ensure that you will be seen by the audience. On the edges of the performing space, you will be able to see the audience better, however, they will not be able to see you as well.





First Time Performers Guide 3/4

Music

Some performers set their magic to music. Jimmy C needs to know before you get to 4F is whether of not you will be supplying music to accompany your performance, and if so, instructions so that things will run smoothly. If Jimmy does not receive this information by April, then you may be performing without music. Jimmy C will be emailing all performers a queue sheet which you need to complete and e-mail to him at jimmycmagic@ yahoo.com with your music; if not, bring the files on a USB Flash drive. There will be time on the morning of your performance to run through your cues. Keep in mind that there will be 6 or 7 other performers on your show, so be aware that you won't have unlimited time to go through a large number of music cues.

Staging

If you have any staging requirements, please let John Michael Hinton, john@ johnismyfriend.com, know as soon as possible.

Microphones

If you have a talking act, you will be given a microphone to amplify your voice. The wireless microphones are head mounted. The microphone fits over one ear and typically clear tape is attached to the microphone arm and your cheek. This prevents the microphone from moving around during your performance. The transmitter is a belt pack that clips onto your pants or belt. If you are from the UK, you will clip the belt pack onto your trousers. Ladies will have different options.

There are two or three microphones in use, so when one performer is finished, their microphone is transferred the next performer. There is sufficient time to set the microphone and you will have help from the stage crew.



First Time Performers Guide 4/4

Table

The table for the close-up is semi-circular. It has a green surface which is suitable for quite a bit of the performers. If your act requires a specific surface to accomplish your magic, bring it along.



Screens and Video

There are two large screens on each side of the performing area that allow some of the audience at the sides and further back, a better view. The camera position is elevated at the back where the AV crew is located. The camera can have a wide shot or if requested can come in for a tighter shot. That can be discussed with the AV crew during your run-through.

Backstage Crew

The backstage crew will either add or remove the table for you. If you have two volunteers while performing at the table, they will also put two chairs for you. There are MCs at each performance, so the transition between performers is covered by their notes and jokes. In some cases, a curtain was also moved into place to allow for a special set-up. You can discuss your requirements with the backstage crew during the rehearsal.


